In 2018, Warrington Community Ambulance Corps had another successful year. We finished the year responding to 2340 emergency calls averaging 6.41 calls per day. We averaged 45 volunteers who compiled 8,110 hrs of volunteer time. We rechassied our second of three vehicles which now has our fleet consisting of a 2010, 2017 and 2018. The 2010 Ambulance is due to be rechassied in the first quarter of 2020.

In 2018, Warrington Community Ambulance Corps was recognized for two awards from the American Heart Association. We were one of 122 EMS agencies in the Commonwealth that actively participated in the Cardiac Arrest Registry to Enhance Survival (CARES) program. This program collects data which helps to improve out of hospital cardiac arrest survival rates. We also received the Mission: Lifeline® - EMS Bronze Plus award. The award recognizes Warrington Community Ambulance's commitment and success in implementing a higher standard of prehospital care by ensuring that every STEMI patient receives treatment according to nationally accepted recommendations and standards.

The future needs of the Warrington Community Ambulance Corps will depend on the squads ability to be prepared for decreased Insurance company reimbursements, increase in call volume and other unknown factors. The squad greatly appreciates the support from Warrington Township and we look forward continuing the great working relationship between the Ambulance Corps and the Township.
