Millcreek Reserve Highlights:

- Gem of Warrington
- · Passive nature reserve
- · Received grant from Land Water Conservation to convert to natural area
- Convert to meadows (wet and dry)
- · Bridges to be added
- Putting in a grant (will need letter of support from BH Committee)
- · Re-forestation
- · Small parking area with small amount of picnic tables
- Signage for take-home-your-own-trash
- · Weisel and Millcreek will all be on a circuit trail

A: Scott should put questions to Natural Lands for fishing

Q: Mike Diorka asked about a project schedule and costs

A: Master plan only in place.

DCNR - grant needed to plant the meadows, parking lot and benches. Foot bridges will be engineered.

Emerson Farm Highlights

- 67 acres
- Detension basins hopefully to be naturalized
- Flashing crossing will be installed at Pickertown (one of our goals completed)
- Could put bluebird houses along the trail

Weisel Highlights

- 3 Grants (45K)
- 3rd week of April 15 trees to be planted along the trail
- May 21 Community Day 9 am -12 noon Clean up along the trails maintenance
- Bike Hike could come up with a maintenance plan to submit to the Board

- EAC was used to get rid of invasives in the Nike Park area near the high tension lines
- E-Link could be used to inform community of where to send their concerns on trail issues.
 - · Add this to our monthly e-link submission from BH committee

Beacon App Innovation

- Being developed
- Same type of App used for Lion's Pride Park
- Stump Rd. Trailhead -all the way to Bradford Dam
- Points can be added to the Beacon App
- · Short and long descriptions
- Download the App from your App Store on your phone
- Beacons are the size of a quarter. It flashes off on your cell phone
