- Mike Diorka suggested having timed instructional sessions at our booth. We could advertise ahead of time that there will be instructional sessions at different times of the day at our booth. Post sessions and times offered at the Bike Hike Booth, along with Warrington Day Ads to get

interest started ahead of time.

Ideas for Instructional Sessions at our booth:

- 1. <u>Bike repair session</u>: Have an expert from a Bike Shop come with a bike and show tips: Andy to contact a resource at local Bike Shop.
 - How to change a tire, pump up tires, etc.
 - Helmet sizing, adjust seat,
 - Biking rules on the road

2. Bike Event Sign Up.

- Gather interest in having a local Bike Ride Event in the Fall, riding the newly connected Warrington trails
- Sign up sheet at the booth

3. Triathlon /Marathon Instruction

A. Have an experienced triathlon or marathon runner come and give tips on how to get started, how to train, types of running shoes, etc.

4. What new Bird Houses are along our trails?

• Invite someone from our township or bird-watch community to speak to what types of bird houses have been installed all around our trails and fields. What types of birds? Learn about the species.

Beacon App Innovation
