 - Helmets required

 - Leaving no one behind pacing the ride to accommodate all types of bikers
 - Stops along the way to see points of interest
 - This is the Bike Hike's first bike ride event, so we will see how it flows for future rides
 - Bring water bottle
- Andy will print out liability waivers to be signed at the booth
- Erynn will pick up waivers

RIDE WITH GPS APP - Peter Norman - Peter sent the following UPDATE:

Started the route in the parking lot at Bradford Road, off County Line. Then rode around back of dam and onto trail, and then all the way to the 202 parkway trail. At every significant intersection I created a Point of Interest (POI) with instructions on what to do at that point. This is not the best way to create instructions and I will have to edit these to the "Cue Sheet", when I learn how.
