- The quorum meeting minutes of June 13, 2016 were approved by all attending Commission members.
- General Business and Action Items
  - Bylaws – WHC members reviewed and approved the final draft prepared by Chair.
  - Penrose Building historical marker is in place now. Chair suggested and WHC supported a recommendation to BOS of having a dedication ceremony of the marker. Opinions on the need of a Township registry of historical markers and other signs were exchanged.
  - Warrington Comprehensive plan historical section – WHC membership approved the final version prepared by Chair and it will be forwarded to BOS.
  - Welcome sign - David Sharp is in the process of completing the document for this project.
  - Victory Gardens – Next hearing will be on July 19, 2016, 1:00pm, at Township Building
  - Chair provided a distinction between “historic” and “historical”. Possibility of changing WHC to represent Warrington Township Historical Commission was explored.
