 - Penrose historical marker – Chair informed attendees that the date for marker dedication is still on-hold until the completion of site landscape arrangements.
 - Welcome to Historic Warrington signs – Attendees suggested a few possible sites for the signs. Attendees also discussed proper content and suitable material for the signs. David expressed his desire of receiving photos of similar signs in other townships/cities for reference.
