Meeting Minutes

- Attending WHC members approved meeting minutes of April 9, 2018.
- General Business and Action Items.
 - Meeting attendees congratulated Mark on his dual membership of WHC and Open Space Task Force. Mark shared his observations on the most recent Open Space activities that could also have historic interests.
 - Carol informed the meeting attendees that BoS and interested parties are actively engaging
 in dialogue on the merits of developing local Historic Preservation easement practice.
 - Proposed Sloane tract development has no obvious impacts to existing Warrington historic sites. However, meeting attendees suggested that WHC/WHS should provide inputs to the open space sign proposed by Open Space Task Force. David agreed to develop inputs for Mark to present to Open Space.
 - Meeting with Doylestown Historical Society needs to be rescheduled.
 - Beaded board paneling from 2436 Street Road recovered by Dr. Ace and other dedicated individuals will be repurposed as wainscoting in the renovation of the School House.
 - There is no change on the status of School house grant proposal to State Agency.

 Comprehensive Plan. Attendees agreed to forward concerns and suggestions on the definition of terms used to describe preservation related issues.
