- 10 Folly Road School Renovation
 - \circ $\;$ WHS will host an open house on October 13 and 14 from 10AM to 2PM.
 - BoS approved WHC's request to allocate \$150K to support the renovation /conversion of the House to a Township museum. WHS will assume the leading role in this project.
