- New Business
 - Historical Preservation-Certified Local Government. Donna of WHS studied Warrington Township Comprehensive Plan update and concluded that our Township could qualify as a Certified Local Government (CLG). As a CLG, Township becomes an active partner in the Federal Historic Preservation Program. Mr. Sparke, together with Donna, will lead the CLG application for the Township.
