Meeting Minutes

- At the request of Chair, Mr. Fred Gaines, Township Liaison, updated meeting attendees on the smooth progress of Warrington Comprehensive Plan review. No big surprise is expected.
- Attending Commission members approved quorum meeting notes of February 13, 2017.
- General Business and Action Items
 - As WHC representative, Harry Lukens attended Mar. 8 meeting of Township Open Space Committee (OSC). Harry reported that no new action item was developed. However, OSC is planning to have a public outing on significant trees in Warrington on April 22. Possibility of having a booth to promote WHS pen-project was explored.
 - o There was no definitive development on the fate of Historic property at 2436 Street Road.
 - Chair circulated current photos of identified Historic Sites submitted by WHC and WHS members. A complete update of the file should be available soon.

New Business

- Geerling property: Chair informed meeting attendees that BOS has set preserving the historic structures as a condition for the property development.
- Pileggi property: The development plan did not include provisions to fix and/or preserve old structures. Mr. Gaines mentioned that perhaps certain tax incentives may be explored to encourage developers to preserve historic interests.
- Chair encouraged the participation of April 22 Warrington Cares Fundraiser activities.
- o Mail: Received Mercer Museum institution pass that may be signed out from Chair.
