Meeting Minutes

- Attending Commission members approved quorum meeting notes of March 13, 2017.
- General Business and Action Items
 - Chair informed attendees that she had received nearly all current photos of identified Historic Sites from WHC and WHS members. Chair expects to complete the project prior to next WHC meeting in May.
 - Geerling property. Chair informed attendees that the developer will keep the historic house on the property. Membership supported Chair to submit a letter to BOS requesting developer to deliver significant historic structural components of the barn.
 - Chair reminded attendees of planned Warrington Cares April 22 activity at Carmel.
- New Business
 - Submitted Murphy tract (2934 Bristol Road) rezoning request includes preservation of the historic house. It is unclear on the fate of its associated barn structure.
 - 2436 Street Road. The new owner will preserve the historic house. Only its garage will be demolished.
 - Rezoning request of St. John Newman Cemetery. The request has no obvious impacts to identified historic structures.
