- General Business and Action Items.
 - Chair informed attendees that her written annual report and oral presentation were well received by BOS. Copies of the report and PowerPoint presentation were shown to all.
 - Updating photos of identified Historic Sites in Warrington would be further delayed.
 - Geerling barn. Mr. Skip Yates is willing to consult on issues related to historic lumber. WHS may contact developer through Township for a site tour.
 - PennDot ruling on historical structures. PennDot's County Line project will impact some historic structures identified by Township but not on National Registry. Assistance from current property owners is needed to negotiate with PennDot.
- New Business
 - Cornell property – Bristol Road. On June 13, Chair will join Township Supervisors and Officers to visit the site to learn its development plan.
 - Illg property- demolition. Developer contacted Chair to request a meeting to explore plans for barn materials prior to its demolition.
 - Truck ordinance. Township has adopted a new length-based truck ordinance.
