- General Business and Action Items.
  - Updating photos of identified Historic Sites in Warrington would be further delayed.
  - Geerling barn. Keeping historic structure is still in developer's plan for the farm.
- New Business
  - Warrington Day. WHC and WHS will work together to develop plans for this event. Mr. Sparke suggested including information on Warrington Day in new residents' WELCOME packages.
  - Research needed. BoS strongly encouraged WHC to identify opportunities from granting agencies, e.g., National Register of Historic Places, Bucks County Conservancy, PennDOT, etc., that may support Township's historic preservation interests. Once identified, Mr. Sparke agreed to lead WHC's efforts to develop grant applications for Township.
  - Cornell property and Illg properties. Prompt arrangements with developers are needed to properly use historic building materials.
