### **Meeting Minutes**

- Attending Commission members approved quorum meeting notes of September 11, 2017.
- General Business and Action Items.
  - Reviews of Warrington Day, Sept 23. This will be done in the meeting of WHS.
  - Murphy tract. No further development is noted.
  - Cornell property. Owner and developer have yet to solidify the development plan.
  - Geerling tract. Mr. Gains reminded WHS to contact developer for a site visit to identify historic building materials.
  - Update on grants/ funding potentials. Using Folly Road School House project as an example, Mr. Sparke summarized his findings:
    - National Register of Historical Places. The School House project may not qualify.
    - Bucks County Conservancy does not support this type of project.
    - Other grant sources. PennDoT, Pennsylvania Historical & Museum Commission, and local business (Home Depot, Lowes) could partially support the project.
    - Mr. Sparke will lead the development of grant applications for the project.
- New Business
  - Street names. WHC supports the Chair to develop a list of prominent local property owners in 1800s or earlier. The list may be used by developers to name new streets added to Township.
