Meeting Minutes

- Chair welcomed Mr. Tom Lorditch for his interests to join WHC. After a brief introduction and interview, all attending WHC members voted to positively recommend Tom's application to BoS for approval.
- WHC members approved March 11, 2019 meeting minutes.
- Chair briefly shared her well-received presentation to BoS on WHC 2018 accomplishments.
- Mark updated attendees on the activities of Open Space Task Force in addressing Mill Creek scenery improvements and Township wildlife management
- Review of status for 10 Folly Road schoolhouse
 - There is a need to obtain Township Engineer's assistance to resolve certain issues essential for the success of schoolhouse restoration project. Specifics are: water flood and deteriorated steel columns in the basement; site plan indicating locations of water, sewer, and power lines to the building; and grading plan of schoolhouse ground along Countyline Road related to PennDot road widening project,
- Development application. WHC found that the retail space proposal at corner of Oakfield and Easton Roads had no impact to known Township historic structures.
- Mail. WHC received activity announcements from Mercer Museum and Library.
