- WHC members approved 10/14/2019 meeting minutes.
- 10 Folly Road School House renovations. At the request of Mr. Lomax, WHS President Doyle Roth indicated that WHC could facilitate the application for a free water hook up from BoS. Both WHC and WHS recognize that the ultimate goal of this important and aspiring renovation is to have a historic Warrington museum for general public. Thus, it is imperative that the site must have reliable water and sewer services to meet the necessary and sufficient health and hygiene conditions for all visitors. All meeting attendees strongly encourage Township to proactively provide all required financial supports and technical engagements to connect public water and sewer lines to the school house building.
