Waiver requests

- Requesting a waiver from the 3ft cover requirement for the storm sewer piping in the area where they are using existing storm sewer system previously approved by Twp. Any new piping installed will meet the requirements
- They are requesting a waiver from the softening buffer requirements around the perimeter off-street parking areas
- Requesting a waiver from the requirement to submit an environmental impact report due to redeveloping the land rather than developing.
- Requesting a waiver to permit Preliminary & Final submissions rather than separate submissions

Mr. Rubenstein made a motion to recommend to the Warrington Township Board of Supervisors preliminary and final approval for the proposed storage facility Site Plan at 2071 County Line Rd. contingent on the compliance with the review letters from CKS Engineers dated 9/14/18, the Bucks County Planning Commission, the Zoning Hearing Board Decision dated 7/23/18 and to the satisfaction and approval of the township engineer. They also recommended granting the six requested waivers. Mr. Cicci seconded. The motion passed 5-0.
