## COMPLETION OF DEVELOPMENT OBLIGATIONS

WHEREAS, Pennsylvania CVS Pharmacy, LLC (hereinafter "CVS") has requested release of escrow and retainage related to the construction of a pharmacy located at Lower State Road and County Line Road, Warrington; and

WHEREAS, CVS has submitted all necessary documentation to complete development which Warrington Township wishes to accept; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it and it is hereby Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Warrington Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, that Warrington Township hereby accepts the following as completion of the CVS construction development:

1. Bill of sale to Warrington Township for ownership of the water and sewer facilities in the State right-of-way;
2. An executed amendment to the Stormwater Controls and Best Management Practices Agreement;
3. one set of approved As-Built Plans for the project;
4. PennDOT sign-offs on the Highway Occupancy Permits for work in the State right-ofway;
5. A Maintenance Bond in the amount of $\$ 6,412.95$ for the improvements covered by the Highway Occupancy Permits for a two-year period.

There are no improvements to be dedicated to Warrington Township.
