Thank you for your recent letter explaining WTWSD's position on the Perfluorinated Compound contamination in Warrington Township. I would like you to know that the Air National Guard and the Air Force are committed to working with you, the Navy, regulators and others in resolving this issue. To that end, we are requesting all sampling and hydrogeologic data pertaining to the PFC contamination from the Navy and will analyze it quickly to assist us in understanding the extent of the contamination in the region. Once we receive this information and review it, I would like to set up a face-to-face meeting at a location of your choosing to discuss our review. I anticipate this meeting to occur in June 2015.
