



ORDINANCE NO. 2017-O-_____

AN ORDINANCE OF WARRINGTON TOWNSHIP, BUCKS COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, RATIFYING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY CHALFONT BOROUGH, DOYLESTOWN BOROUGH, DOYLESTOWN TOWNSHIP, NEW BRITAIN BOROUGH, NEW BRITAIN TOWNSHIP, WARWICK TOWNSHIP, AND WARRINGTON TOWNSHIP, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING HOUGH ASSOCIATES TO COLLECT RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL RECYCLING DATA AND PREPARE PA DEP 904 RECYCLING GRANT APPLICATIONS, REPEALING ALL INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF, PROVING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, by Intergovernmental Agreement dated December 2014 (the "Agreement"), Doylestown Borough entered into an agreement with Chalfont Borough, Doylestown Borough, Doylestown Township, New Britain Borough, New Britain Township, Warwick Township, and Warrington Township (collectively the "Municipalities"), which, inter alia, authorized Hough Associates to collect residential and commercial recycling data and prepare residential and commercial recycling data, and prepare PA DEP 904 Recycling Grant applications on behalf of the Municipalities for the years 2017-2021; and,

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 53 Pa.C.S. §2301, et seq., requires all intergovernmental agreements to be approved by ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, Warrington Township desires to ratify and approve the Agreement by the enactment of this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Board of Supervisors of Warrington Township as follows:

1. The Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby ratified and approved pursuant to the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 53 Pa.C.S. §2301, et seq.
2. All other provisions of the Township's Code of Ordinances, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect. All other Ordinances or provisions of the Township's Code of Ordinances inconsistent herewith or in conflict with any of the terms hereof are, to the extent of said inconsistencies or conflicts are hereby specifically repealed.

3. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any section, clause, sentence, part or provision thereof shall be held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional section, clause, sentence or part of a provision had not been included herein.
4. All provisions of this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after the approval and adoption.

Three Year Agreement Authorizing Hough Associates to Collect Residential and Commercial Recycling Data and Prepare PA DEP 904 Recycling Grant Applications for Warrington Township

Warrington Township authorizes Hough Associates to collect recycling data for 2014, 2015, and 2016. Hough Associates will prepare joint grant applications with other area municipalities provided that the applications increase the recycling grant for Warrington Township. Hough Associates will file individual applications for the Township if it does not want to be included in the joint applications.

Hough Associates will:

- Prepare and mail annual data collection forms to haulers for reporting the recycling tonnage collected in Warrington Township and to identify where these recyclables were processed.
- Prepare and mail annual forms to recycling processors for reporting recycling residue rates.
- Contact all haulers and processors that did not respond to the mailing.
- Compile the annual recycling data reported to the Township and to Hough Associates in both hard copy and on a computer database. Data will be retained for 4 years following filing.
- Prepare and file the annual Bucks County Recycling Survey Report due in February.
- Prepare and mail annual commercial recycling education to township businesses.
- Analyze the benefits of a joint grant application with other Bucks County municipalities.
- Prepare and file the joint 904 Recycling Performance Grant Application forms with other municipalities on or before DEP's filing deadlines.

Warrington Township will provide Hough Associates with annual update of the commercial entities that operated in the Township for use in data collection and the recycling education mailing.

Warrington Township agrees to pay Hough Associates a fixed price of \$11,500 per year for these services according to the following schedule:


- \$5,750 January 31
- \$5,750 July 31

The Township may take a 2% discount if a single payment of \$11,270 is made by January 31.

In the event of a DEP audit, Hough Associates will represent the Township at no additional cost.
